THE VOTING PAPER

The format of the Voting Paper which will be used for the Referendum 2002 is as follows:

QUESTION

On the 12th July 2002 the Foreign Secretary, Jack Straw, in a formal statement in the House of Commons, said that after twelve months of negotiation the British Government and Spain are in broad agreement on many of the principles that should underpin a lasting settlement of Spain's sovereignty claim, which included the principle that Britain and Spain should share sovereignty over Gibraltar.

Do you approve of the principle that Britain and Spain should share sovereignty over Gibraltar?

Please read it carefully and consider the option (YES or NO) for which you wish to vote.

You will be voting in complete secrecy. Your voting paper cannot be traced back to you. It contains a serial number to enable a check to be carried out, if necessary, to confirm that there are no false papers among the votes cast. But no voting paper can be identified with any individual person.
