This proposition will authorize the District to pay the costs of all such improvements; to issue not to exceed \$6,975,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum term of 30 years; and levy annual excess property tax levies to pay and retire such bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 2003-5 of the District. This proposition would authorize a three-tenths of one percent (0.3%) sales and use tax to provide funds to replace lost state revenue and retain law enforcement officers and law and justice employees, employ additional personnel, and replace, repair and maintain law and justice equipment in the county and the cities of Walla Walla, College Place, Waitsburg and Prescott.
